

This Privacy Policy is provided to make you aware of how Schiavello Group Companies collects, uses and manages information of visitors to the Site. Schiavello Group and its related entities view the personal privacy of users as an important issue and are committed to maintaining the security of personal information provided to Schiavello Group by users in accessing the Site. This policy forms part of the terms of use of the Site, and describes how Schiavello treats personal information it receives through your use of the Site.

What Information Do We Collect and How Is It Used?

Schiavello Group collects the following information regarding visitors to the Site: domain name, name, information regarding what pages are accessed, information volunteered by you, such as survey information, e-mail address, or site registrations, and your preferred means of communication. Schiavello Group collects and logs this information for statistical purposes. Schiavello Group also uses this information in order to provide you with a personalised experience when you visit the Site.

Through the use of a cookie, Schiavello Group can record the pages you visit and the information you require. Through analysis of these records, Schiavello provides you with an improved service when you revisit the Site. Except as stated above, no attempt is made to identify users or their browsing activities except, in the event of an investigation, where a law enforcement agency may exercise a warrant to inspect logs, or where Schiavello Group believes it is required to collect and produce relevant electronic documentation to fulfil its obligations to third parties, including statutory organisations or authorities.

Schiavello Group endeavours to use and disclose your personal information only in limited circumstances. Schiavello Group will do so if it is necessary to protect any copyright or intellectual property in the material in the Site, or if it is necessary to enforce the Terms of Use. We may use third-party advertisers to deliver advertisements to your web browser while you are viewing the Site. These third parties may be supplied with, or may have access to, your personally identifiable information, but only for the purpose of providing their services to you.

Except as specifically stated in this Privacy Policy, we will not share your personally identifiable information with a company that is not associated with Schiavello Group.

Cookies

A cookie is a small data file that may be written to your hard drive when you visit a website. A cookie file can contain information (such as a user ID) that the website uses to track the pages you have visited. The only personal information a cookie can contain is information you personally supply. A cookie cannot read data from your hard disk or read cookie files created by other websites. This Site uses cookies to track user traffic patterns and to improve service when you revisit the Site. You can set your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie, providing you with the opportunity to either accept or reject it. You can also refuse all cookies by turning them off in your browser. However, fully functional access to the Site may require the use of cookies.
